Our Heavenly Father's Day

What comes to mind when you consider the term "Father's Day?" Time spent with family reminiscing what wonderful things your dad did for you growing up? How he worked to love, guide, protect and provide for you? Is the first thing that comes to mind perhaps the Sunday celebration of "Father's Day" where you take/took the time to travel to his house and present to him your gifts of love, gratitude, and appreciation? Maybe it's a special meal as you and your siblings all gather around the same table to eat, enjoy, and celebrate?
